Avaran traveled countless miles to High School and Little Britches rodeos to support his older brothers and sisters and became a competitor himself. Through all of his travels Avaran endeared himself to everyone he met.

In 2005, Avaran moved to Crawford, Nebraska with his family where he attended Crawford Schools. He was involved in Football, wrestling (qualified 2 times to state), All School Plays (selected Best Actor) and Band. He enjoyed playing his guitar, singing, writing poetry, and reading. His enthusiasm was evident in whatever he chose to participate in.

Avaran had an interest in the military and was very proud of his involvement in the National Guard. Avaran attended the First Community Church in Crawford. His faith was a significant factor in his life. Avaran appreciated and loved his family. He thoroughly enjoyed playing with his nieces and nephews.

Avaran died at the age of 19 in Alliance, Nebraska on June 21, 2013.
