On the agenda, recognition of two national merit semifinalists, Lane Chasek and Abigail McFee. Also, Greta Welch as a Jack Kent Cooke Young Scholar. Commendations also go out to those volunteers who assisted or painted the home football bleachers. New business will include discussion and necessary action on the first reading of a policy involving ceremonies, observations, and the pledge of allegiance.
