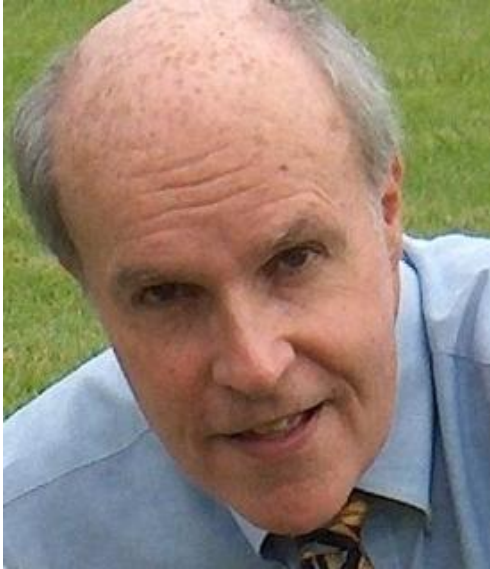

I was a recipient of a Creative Writing Fellowship in Poetry from the Arizona Commission of the Arts," Kenney said.

"I will be presenting Beginning Creative Nonfiction.
