A car show and poker run will be taking place at the Black Hills Saloon at 1:00 p.m., and at 5:00 p.m., the school will host an all-school reunion and dinner. Stick around for a street dance at the community center starting at 9:00 p.m.,

featuring TrYAD band and Brett Hamilton.

Sunday

On Sunday, there's breakfast at the school from 8:00-10:00 a.m., and cowboy church at 9:00 a.m. at the Black Hills Saloon. More arts, crafts, and food booth fun abound at the town park, and the History Museum will again be open at the community center.
