(Neb.)-Eagles Turn Back Hardrockers In Four Sets

RAPID CITY, S.D. – The Chadron State College volleyball team snapped its recent losing streak by upending South Dakota School of Mines in four sets 23-25, 25-17, 25-20, 25-20 Tuesday at the King Center.

The Eagles, now 5-22 overall, will host Regis and Metro State this weekend as they close out the regular season. First serve with Regis is set for 7 p.m., while the Eagles and Roadrunners will meet at 6 p.m.

The Eagles' offense was clicking in the final three sets Tuesday and as a team they hit .197, while limiting South Dakota Mines to .114.

[Mallory Irvine](#) led all attackers with 15 kills (.452 hitting percentage) and [Jessica Jester](#) added 12 more and hit .310.

Also for Chadron State, [Mollie Jones](#) had nine kills, [Erika Roybal](#) had six and [Lexi Hoagland](#) chipped in five.

Setter [Justine Ackie](#) led CSC with 26 set assists and the Eagles' other setter, [Alyssa Bauer](#), had 17. Both of them also had two kills and [Kristina Harter](#) had a match-high 26 digs.

The Eagles performed well at the net, finishing with 20 total blocks. South Dakota Mines had just four.

Irvine had a team-high six, Hoagland added five and Jester finished with four.

[Arielle Boone](#), who played in the final two sets, finished with three blocks.
