

(Neb.)-Traffic Stops Net 188 Pounds Of Pot in Nebraska

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) - The Nebraska State Patrol says two separate traffic stops netted 188 pounds of pot and led to the arrest of two drivers.

Officials say a trooper stopped an eastbound pickup truck for speeding on I-80 near Kearney on Sunday. A search turned up 83 pound of marijuana in three suitcases. The driver, a Mexican national, is charged with possession of marijuana with intent to deliver.

The patrol says on Friday, a trooper stopped an eastbound car for speeding on I-76 near Big Springs in western Nebraska. A search led to the discovery of 105 pounds of pot in two duffel bags in the trunk of the car.
