According to Karl Bieber with Century Link, an ice storm north of Harrison has caused power outages and impacted service for exchanges in the area.

Bieber said that Century Link technicians are working to have power – and services - restored as quickly as possible. However, that is causing problems with people trying to get a hold of the Dawes County Sheriff's office in Crawford.
