

(Neb.)-Eagles Snap Losing Skid At Highlands

LAS VEGAS, N.M. – [Mollie Jones](#) had 11 kills and [Mallory Irvine](#) added 10 more as the Eagles snapped their seven-match losing streak by defeating New Mexico Highlands 25-23, 21-25, 25-20, 25-14 in Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference action Saturday evening at the Wilson Complex.

The Eagles, now 4-15 overall and 2-9 in the RMAC, had one of their better hitting performances of the season posting an attack percentage of .226.

While Jones, who hit a match-high .333, and Irvine, who had just four hitting errors, were the only Eagles to finish in double digit kills, they didn't have to carry the offense.

[Erika Roybal](#) had seven kills and [Lexi Hoagland](#) and [Jessica Jester](#) had six apiece.

Chadron State also played well at the net – the Eagles finished with 15 total blocks led by five from Irvine – and served six aces.

[Justine Ackie](#), who led CSC with 21 set assists, served two aces and Jester added two aces and four blocks.

Libero [Kristina Harter](#) added a match-high 17 digs and also provided two kills from the backrow.

Chadron State will host three matches next week, beginning Thursday against CSU-Pueblo. First serve is set for 7 p.m.
